

Sixth Grade Summer Reading

Summer is upon us and that means it's time for summer reading. Students must choose two of the following books to read during the summer and then write a book report to be turned into their English teacher once school begins.

The report must be typed, double spaced using Times New Roman 12-pt font.

The reports must include the following:

- The title, author, genre, number of pages and setting of the book as the first paragraph.
- A description of two characters from the book
- A summary of the main story
- Three quotes you found inspiring or important and an explanation of why you chose each quote
- What you learned from reading the book

The report must be at least two full pages, double spaced and must be proofread before it is turned in. Spelling and grammar do count. There should also be a title page and the paper should be put in a report folder. (If you need clarification on the folder, please see Mrs. Wimble or Mrs. Perez)

The students may choose any two books from the following list.

1. Little Women by Louisa May Alcott
2. Anne of Green Gables by Lucy Maud Montgomery
3. 20,000 Leagues Under the Sea by Jules Verne
4. The Lion, the Witch and the Wardrobe by C. S. Lewis
5. The Borrowers by Mary Norton
6. Black Beauty by Anna Sewell
7. The Jungle Book by Rudyard Kipling
8. White Fang by Jack London
